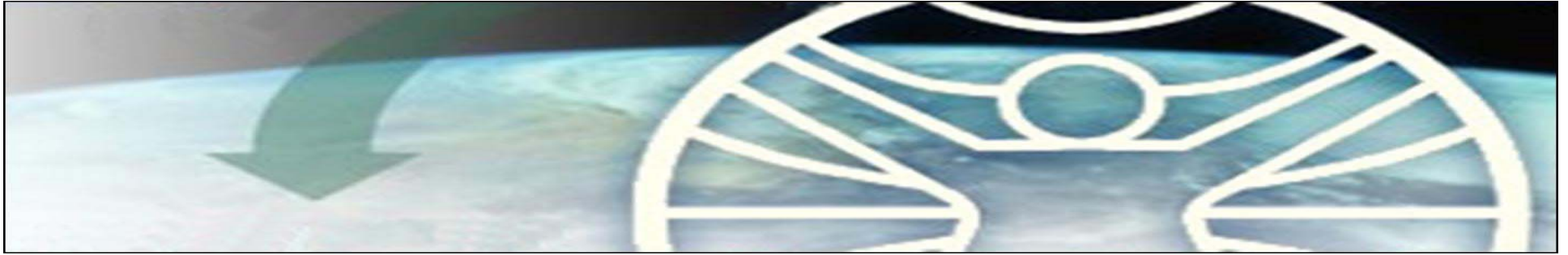

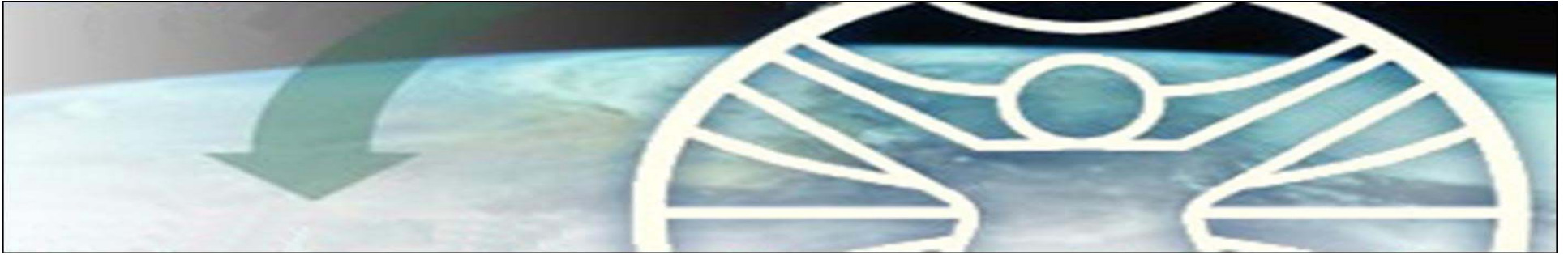

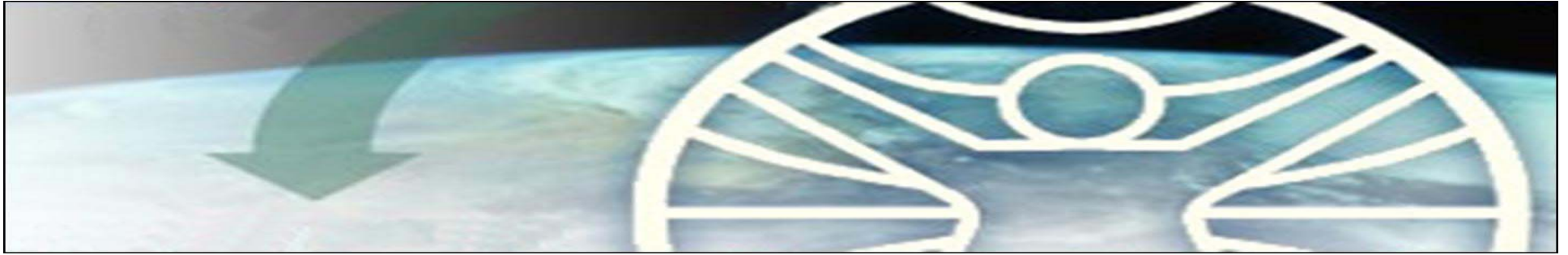
The IHDP Strategic Plan 2007-2015

 - Science Policy Interaction



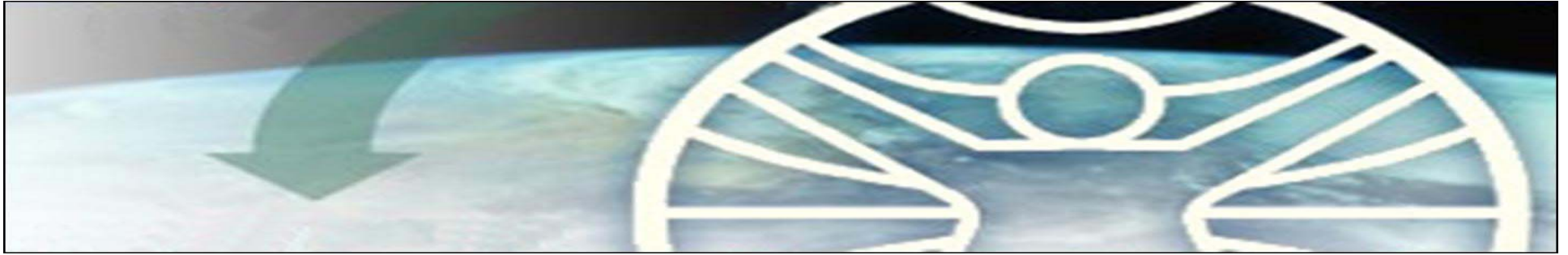
The IHDP research agenda – the IDGEC example

- Follow on project: „Earth System Governace“, including a strong cross-cutting component



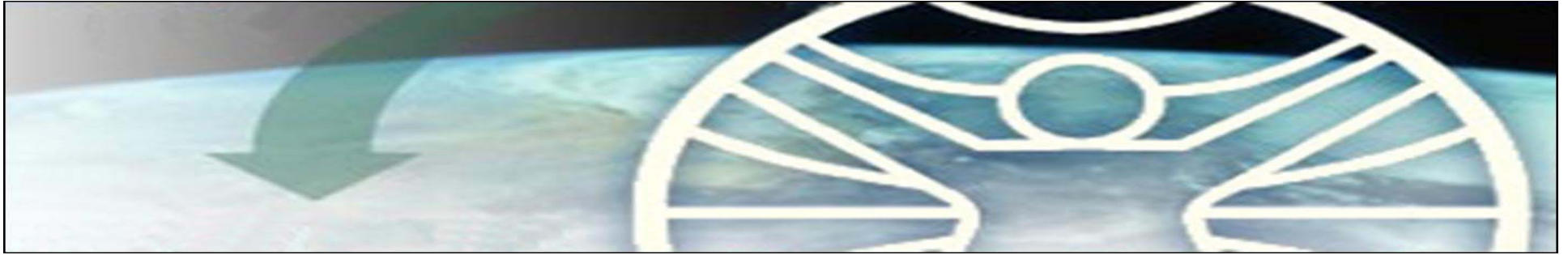

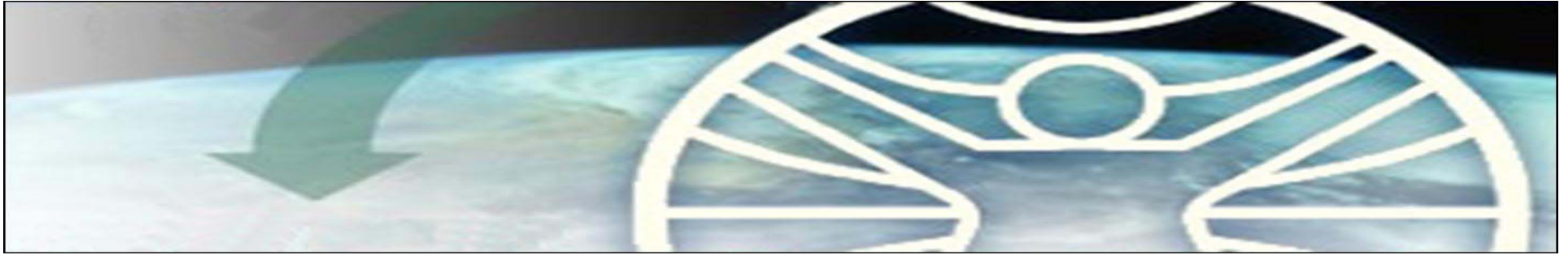
